- Embedded tutor PALS (Panther Strong 2026 Strategic Plan expansion goa)











Existing Sidewalks Bioscience to Gray Lot






SoFi Elements #1 – Drop Off Circle








SoFi Elements #3 – REPLACE Sidewalks




SoFi Elements #3 – NEW 10' w Sidewalks








SoFi – NEW Site Lighting Plan





SoFi – Overall Site Development Plan






SoFi – Overall Site Development Plan





Financial Review

- Audit will be generally completed in early 2025
 - Financial Audit underway now
 - Typically, an identical report to what you see today
 - Formatting changes are occasionally requested
 - Using templates provided by AG
 - Findings, if any
 - Operational Audit next year
 - Policy and Legal reviews
 - Special topics
 - Standard findings expected sometimes statewide topics
 - Other state reporting requirements throughout the year
