

PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED COURSE AND USER FEE ADJUSTMENT

(LAKE WORTH, FL – July 14, 2020) The Palm Beach State College District Board of Trustees will be considering course and user fee adjustments at its next regularly scheduled meeting on August 11, 2020.

This change affects the course listed below:

1. Firefighter 2 (FFP0031): Revised course in inventory (previously FFP0020). The \$280.49 fee covers fuel, plywood, apparatus maintenance, medium-density fiberwood (flashover), self-contained breathing apparatus, cleaning disinfectant, rope, and hay.
